## Capture growth opportunities and protect against market losses

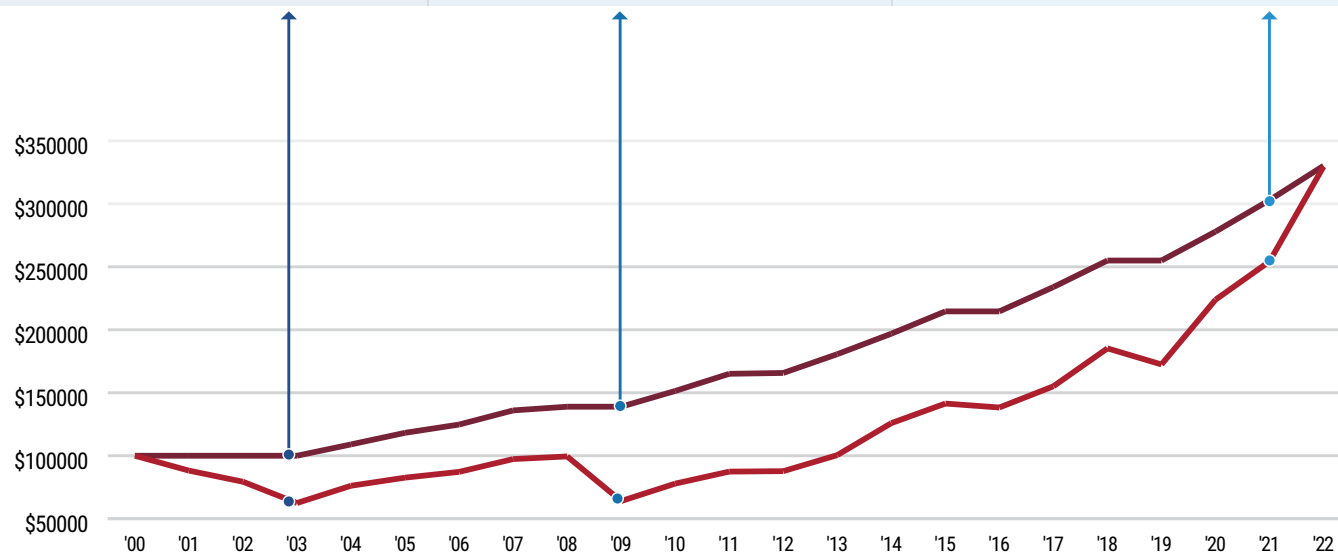
